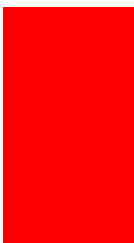

MBC is not in the money-making business. Our purpose is to prepare preachers and train teachers. We have constantly kept our tuition among the lowest in the brotherhood. This gives the “hands on” training needed and expected of all MBC graduates. Additionally, each student takes part in the Spring Campaign and each student attends chapel services while on campus.
